2016 Iowa YHEC Recap

Iowa Youth Hunter Education Challenge, YHEC, had another successful year, this year marked 24 years for the Iowa program. While our numbers were reduced due to conflicting events and youth being involved in multiple activities and last minute cancelations we still had 38 participants, 18 coaches and over 55 volunteers.

Participants represented the following areas: Clinton County (23), North Linn Fish and Game club (8), Boone Shooting Sports (2) and Eddyville (5).

Instead of canceling the event, due to reduced numbers, the group decided to condense the event to two days. The teams still checked-in on Friday night at Wesley Woods and the events and awards took place on Saturday. Saturday, teams woke up to an unexpected rain storm that lasted longer than 3 hours. With the rain and lightning strikes delaying the scheduled events we were able to adjust the rotations and take the Exam and Wildlife ID test indoors at Wesley Woods. Late Saturday morning, the teams headed to the Warren County Izaak Walton League and Lake Ahquabi to finish the remaining six events.
