Hi. This is Rod Goodrich, I am the current Trap Chair for the Club. I would like to get everyone together that is involved with trap so we can discuss the trap program and what direction we would like to go with it.

We all know that Jim Lear had been working on starting to get the ATA shooting going again. But due to his health issues Jim and I decided to put it on hold. I have had people ask me if we are going to still do ATA shoots or the 50/50 programs. Holding ATA shoots can be a great money maker for the club and also give those that are registered shooters to get our birds needed for qualifying for ATA shoots. But to hold these shoots it takes a lot of help both in the trap building and out at the trap fields. These shoots are held on weekends and mostly on Sundays and scheduling can be a problem with other gun clubs.

The 50/50 programs can be held during the week in the evenings and do not require as much personnel. I also have people tell me that they do not want to go this way and just stay with open shoots, leagues, youth shooting, and 5 stand.

We need to discuss cost of shooting and the prices we charge and the supplies we sell. We have discussed this at board meetings about youth shooting and the price of open shooting for member verses nonmember. Also we need to discuss how we can better handle our shooting supplies we sell over the counter and how we can better promote sales.

I have also been asked about the unsupervised shooting at the club. Having people come out and opening the traps and practicing without supervision and I have had people wanting keys to be able to do this. I brought this to the board to get their opinion on this and they are not in favor of giving out keys and questioned people and youth shooting unsupervised. I think that the trap committee and coaches need to meet about the use of the grounds, trap machines, voice activation, and general practices.



We have a great club and lots of great people running things, the youth program, and the coaches that are spending countless hours to keep this going. I want everyone to let me know when they think what day of week or a time would work the best. Please contact me by phone, text, or e-mail.
