Simpson College announced Monday it has hired Scott Moniot as its full time coach for the shooting sports club. He will officially begin at the college Aug. 1, 2016.

Simpson's shooting sports club has been in existence since 2010 and has been overseen by a faculty advisor.

Moniot has most recently been Director of Development for the Scholastic Clay Target Program (SCTP) where he worked with teams, coaches and high schools around the country developing their skills and helping them grow as well as connecting them with the resources of the national organization.

"Scott has been a great asset to the SCTP and I'm sure will be the same for Simpson College," said Tom Wondrash, SCTP National Director. "Just like our program opens doors for its athletes, it also opens doors for its staff and many volunteers around the country. We wish Scott nothing but the best in his new opportunity with Simpson!"

"I've always been a coach at heart," Moniot said. "I realized at an early age the impact a coach could have and it's always been my passion."

At Simpson, Moniot sees great potential.

"I really believe in what Simpson is doing as a small college," he said. "It has a lot to offer and it has the best of both worlds in terms of being in a small community yet very close to a bigger city."

Adam Brustkern, chemistry professor at Simpson College, has been the shooting sports club advisor for the past five years. He is excited about what adding a full time coach means for Simpson and the club.

"Given Scott's experience, I have no doubt in his ability to take the club to the next level," Brustkern said. "By recruiting a core of students who are dedicated to the shooting sports, Coach Moniot will be able to increase the competitive

nature of the club, while still fulfilling the club's core mission of promoting safe and responsible participation in the shooting sports."

Moniot says his goals for the club are to draw as much interest from prospective students as possible and give them the opportunity to be successful in their education and continue their passion for shooting sports.

"Very few people will go on to make a living in competitive shooting," Moniot said. "I want to make room in the club for everyone, from the casual shooter to those who are more serious about competition and let everyone have a positive experience."

Grandview College - Starts New Shooting Program and Selects Warren Co. Ikes for Home Grounds

Here is some info on Grandview Coach Charlie Mundy

Charlie Mundy will lead the **inaugural** Grand View shooting sports team that will begin competing in the fall of 2016. Mundy comes to Grand View after three very successful seasons at Southwestern Community College (SWCC).

- Was instrumental in the startup of the first collegiate shooting team as a school-funded varsity sport at SWCC
- Held a seat on the Scholastic Clay Target Program's (SCTP) Board as Collegiate
- Implemented the first collegiate shooting conference in the state of Iowa
- Has assisted many Iowa colleges in the startup of new programs

In his three years as shooting sports head coach Mundy's Teams:

- Won a total of 15 competitions and placed in 70 competitions with 34 first place and 10 runner-up finishes
- Qualified for the national tournament three times where his teams placed 6th, 7th, 15th
- Placed one male and one female in the top 10 at nationals
- Had six individuals qualify at nationals to apply for Olympic Training Camp
- Won Iowa Collegiate Conference Championships 2014, 2015
- Went undefeated in conference competitions 2014, 2015
- Conference runners-up 2015, 2016
- Male State Champion 2015
- Female State Champion 2015
- Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Team State Champions 2015
- Won state collegiate title in 2015 and team recognized by the United States Congress for demonstrating hard work, dedication, and perseverance in delivering results

Mundy is a National Rifle Association of America (NRA) Certified Shotgun Coach, a National Rifle Association of America (NRA) Certified Range Safety Officer (RSO), and an Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Certified Shotgun Coach.

9am – Noon Range of experts will spend time discussing firearm types (mainly rifles and Shotguns), operations, Marksmanship basics including how to shoot for accuracy, scopes vs iron sights, etc. Instructors will discuss Trap vs Skeet shotgun shooting and how to lead a target. Of course Safety will be a big topic in the discussions.

Noon – 1pm Lunch and Safety Talks. Lunch will be provided for registered Scouts, Veterans, Scout Leaders and Isaac Walton volunteers. Non volunteering Adults who wish to eat the cost of lunch is \$5. Lunch will be a hotdog meal with Beans, chips and pasta salad and Kool-Aid.

1pm – 4 pm. Shooting Activities. This includes the opportunity to shoot several firearms. Scouts are not required to shoot any firearms. Some firearms will have min age limit requirement for safety. Firearms that will be available: **Rifles: AR15 (.223/5.56), 22LR. For shotguns .410, 20ga, and 12ga for 18+ year olds.** There possibly may be additional firearms (rifles) of other calibers. Rifles will use paper targets. Shotguns will use clay pigeons. Clays will be tossed by Isaac Walton League of Warren County mechanical throwers. There will also be optional stationary clays for those shooting .410 if desired.

Please note below some of the events rules. This is not a full list. Full list will be available and talked about day of event.

- **During the Scouting Event there will be NO PERSONAL firearms OR AMMO allowed.**
- Scouts this is a Class A uniform event.
- Hearing and Eye Protection required for all during shooting events. You may provide your own or we will have ear plugs and safety glasses available
- Must attend entire day to participate in shooting events of the afternoon.
- We intend to have a lot of fun and safety is our main concern. Scouts and Adults must follow Range Safety Officers, Instructors and Event coordinators instructions. Minor violations will result in having to take safety instruction over if available. Major violations and you will be asked to leave.
- There are restricted areas both inside the buildings and outside. Both will be posted as restricted either verbally or by signs. Scouts and non-authorized adults violating these restrictions will be asked to leave.
- Treat all firearms like they are loaded. Even the Orange/Blue guns used in demonstrations and practice.
- There are 2 parental waivers that will need to be signed to attend. 1-BSA and 1- Izaak Walton League of Warren County.
- Ammo is handled by authorized adults only. Do not pick up empty shells unless instructed by the Range Safety Officer.
- If leaving early Scouts must check out with an event Coordinator.

EVENTS:

- **Center fire rifle**- Open class bench rest. 100 yards four five shot strings.
- **Rim fire rifle**- Open class bench rest. 100 yards four five shot strings.
- **Rim fire rifle**- Iron sights. 25 yards four five shot strings.
- **Modern muzzle loader**- Open class bench rest. 100 yards four five shot strings.
- **Primitive muzzle loader**- Iron sights. 25 yards four five shot strings.
- **Center fire hand gun**- Iron sights. 25 yards four five shot strings.
- **Trap**- 25 16 yard targets and 25 handicap targets. Handicap will be the score you shoot at 16 yards.

Cost is \$10 per event \$15 for trap, includes lunch. \$5 of each entry will go to prize money. This is also a CMP qualification opportunity.

Open class events will allow any combination of optics and rest the shooter wants to use. The rest of the events will be iron sights standing. We will not be going down range to check targets between strings. Bring a spotting scope if you want to check targets.
