INDIANOLA TRAP STATE SHOOT RESULTS

The State Trap Shoot was held in Cedar Rapids during the first week of June. Some notable accomplishments of Indianola Trap Team include:

Breydon Paxson shot a 198 which tied him for 4th with 8 other shooters. He also tied for first for the league season championship with 12 shooters. Breydon was unable to attend the shootoffs and had to forfeit his position. However, he forfeited to attend the National Junior Olympics shoot where he finished in second place! At the state shoot Breydon shot singles, doubles and handicap. His score of 390/400 earned him second place high overall score.

Cannon Roberson tied with 2 other shooters for 5th place with a score of 194. He won the shootoff to secure 5th place. The first round of the shootoff was from the 16 yard line where Cannon and 1 of the other shooters shot 25 straight, the other shooter was eliminated. For the 2nd round, they were moved back to the 22 yd line where Cannon shot a 23 to win the shootoff.



The Team had a lot of shooters step up and shoot better than they had all season. The Team had 1 100 straight, 2 75 straight, 2 50 straight and 17 25 straight. Sixty-eight Indianola shooters attend state, 20 middle school and 48 high school.
