FROM THE PRESIDENT - CRAIG

The lead reclamation has been completed except for a few empty drums that will be picked up. We are looking to move some of the dirt on the rifle range to fill in area's on the lead area to avoid any ponds of water that could develop. This will accomplish several things making the range a bit longer at 150 yards on the far end, 125 yards for the middle range. And with the shot fall area being leveled out and any remainders moved into our SE area for the Archery range too.

We are instituting hours for the rifle range starting at 8 am to sunset. Several neighbors made me and others aware that shooting as early as 6:30 on a weekend isn't going to work. I will have the hours form that is posted attached as part of the newsletter. Also I have put together a list of do's and don'ts for the rifle range that will be subject to updates as time goes on I am thinking.

Membership is still growing with the rifle range as the main factor due to Banner Range not being open for business. We have gotten several family memberships as well as individuals too. A couple of things to point out though is no bird shot is to be used on the rifle range. You can sight in slug barrels on your shotguns but using bird shot has a way of shredding our target stands. Picking up your brass is always appreciated because your mother isn't going to follow you around to do this. Also no explosive items such as tannerite due to the noise as well as the fire exposure it can cause.

One of our members mentioned he will be bringing out steel targets he will plan on leaving for others of us to use on the range. These may be setup out on the 100 yard line is what it sounds like. I have been working on rebuilding some of our target stands to be used. I am also going to have one setup with cardboard so that others can shoot it with BB and Pellet guns. This one should be left down on the South end with the other pistol range area. My Granddaughter had a blast using their BB and Pellet guns.

If you have some spare time to help out on the grounds please contact Dave Smith at 515-770-4398 and he can work with you to setup some trimming, mowing, and other grounds work as needed. This chapter is way more than one man or person can handle. You are all appreciated that help out with the grounds. Same thing with those that help out with our Trap open shooting night and other trap events.

Please be safe and courteous always, sight and hearing protection to be worn.

Hours are 8am to sunset, too many early shooters have upset neighbors.

Please clean up after yourselves means targets on the range and the brass on the shooting line too. We have brooms on the line to help you.

NO birdshot on the rifle range! This tends to destroy our targets way too soon. Only time shotguns used are with slugs to sight in for hunting.

NO Tannerite or explosive items used on the range. Besides noise they can cause grass fires as well.

So far, we are ok with centerfire semi auto rifles up to .50 caliber. We are a family and youth chapter so be aware of who we have out on the range.

Always check the calendar at www.warrenikes.com to see if the range is closed before you drive all the way out. Most all the closings are posted. There may be times when work or mowing is being done that did not get on the calendar.

And finally, please enjoy our range as these improvements have been a long time coming to our chapter.
