- **Where:** Red Cedar Chapter of Izaak Walton League, Highway 150 North, Vinton, IA
- **When:** Saturday August 26, 2017
- **Practice Time:** 7:30 a.m.- 9:30 a.m. \$5.00 per person per round of 25 targets
- **Program Time:** 9:40 a.m. (First 2 squads will shoot.)
- **Program:** 50 Total Targets Adults and Youth
 - **16 Yard Targets** 25 birds - total broken birds will figure handicap on the squad.
 - **Handicap Targets** 25 birds -based on squad's average at 16 yards, min. of 19 yards.
- **Entry Fee per Squad:** \$75.00 / 5 person squad - **pre-registration is a must for this event, by email or phone call to Lisa McIntyre by August 16, 2017. We have a limit of squads this year so call or email early.**

- **Late Entry Fee per Team:** **\$100.00 after August 16 - you still need to contact Lisa as soon as possible after this date, if you still wish to shoot.**
- **Other:**
 - Youth are age 18 and under. A current paid **Youth or family memberships – Iowa Division will pay the entry fee once for a youth to shoot**, Membership card # will be required. However a non-member youth can still shoot and pay full entry fee of \$15. Any youth may shoot on more than 1 squad, and can also shoot on an adult squad.
 - Adults are age 19 and older. **All adult shooters must be a current paid IWLA member.** Membership card # will be required. Any adult member may shoot on more than 1 squad.
 - Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for both adults & youth. Individual "High Gun" score in each category: men, women, youth male and youth female.
 - Food will be available 8 a.m. – 2 p.m. or until they run out.
