IOWA DIVISION & OTTUMWA CHAPTER TRAP SHOOT

The Iowa Division and Ottumwa IWLA Chapter State Convention Trap Shoot was held in Ottumwa, Iowa on Saturday April 29, which wrapped up our 2018 Iowa Division convention. The morning started out a little chilly and we had some wind but nothing too bad. Practice took place between 8 a.m. – 10:30 a.m. and our 50-bird program started around 10:45 a.m. The program consisted of 25 birds at 16 yards and 25 birds at a handicap yard line for both the adult and youth divisions. The adult's handicap was figured by the squad's average at the 16 yard line, with the minimum of 19 yards. The youth shot their handicap from the 19 yards. Awards were given to the top 3 teams in each division. Plus 4 high gun trophies; 2 for the youth division, 1 female and male youth, and 2 for the adult division 1 female and 1 male. (More about these folks below.)

Shooters came from BF Carroll, Grundy Tama, Ottumwa, Warren Co., and Waterloo chapters. We had 9 youth teams (44 shooters) and 11 adult teams (55 shooters). Some of our youth shooters also shot on an adult team as well. We also had a few youth that only shot in the adult division. About mid-way through, an Ottumwa youth had asked about if it would be possible to form another squad for he wanted his dad to try trap since he loved it so much and wanted to share this experience with him. So Ottumwa Ikes #3 team was formed, the dad did ok for never doing it before. They were even shooting the same gun, so passing it back and forth.

We didn't have any perfect score this year, but four shooters (3 youth and 1 adult) came close with 48 targets each.
