**FROM THE PRESIDENT**

It has come to our attention that we have a need to replace our septic system. We do not have any estimates yet other than a quick one that says could be as high as \$30,000?? I was in hopes of maybe half that. We do have some general funds and maybe access to the state lkes for a loan too. We just need to get that lead shot harvested so that we can use those funds then for the septic. What would be nice is to not run a lateral field over to the hillside north of the parking lot like this line is now. THEN we could use that whole area for parking and eventually gravel it would be nice.

One lead outfit out of Kansas City can't get to us until next year. Rod Goodrich says that Jasper County gun club has someone from Wisconsin coming this year. Maybe we can see if they would be able to add us onto that list since we are an hour away? We are looking maybe this week or next to have them come and take samples from our range.

Then all that dirt they are sifting though we could have them dump it over in the Archery range area! The other thing we can do after we get that lead out of the ground is extend the rifle range back so that we have an area of at least 150 yards rather than the 130 or so we have now and take that 100 yard range back to say 125 yards. We could then have that dirt trucked on out to the archery area as well. We will have to see what we can come up with for bids and donation of time or equipment too. I think a lot will center then on us "Getting the Lead out" and then we can get a lot more things done.

It was also brought up at our board meeting that Larry Lepper has stepped down now as treasurer and Kevin McCombs is filling in for the rest of this term and will be on board for elections this August. Speaking of which we have 5 positions up for election. President, 1st Vice President, Membership, Trap Chair, and Treasurer. Election will be held at our membership meeting in August.
