

# WARREN COUNTY IZAAK WALTON POLICY ON SHOOTING SUPPLIES SALES TO MEMBERS


## GENERAL INFORMATION


One of the benefits of being a member of the Warren County (IA) Chapter of the Izaak Walton League of America (WC Ikes) is the ability to purchase selected shooting supplies through the chapter at our wholesale pricing. These shooting supplies are typically ordered by the Trap Chair or his/her representative. Supplies may consist of the following or additional items as determined by the Trap Chair: Ammunition, shot, powder, wads, primers, etc. It is the sole discretion of the Trap Chair on what items are ordered. Except for shot shells, it is not the intent of the WC Ikes to inventory items for resale. The price paid by members who meet the ordering qualifications stated below will be the sum of: a) the cost of the item, b) a reasonable fee to cover any freight charges, and c) Iowa sales tax and any local option sales taxes. Below are general conditions for purchasing shooting supplies through the WC Ikes:

1. The purchaser must be a current member in good standing of the WC Ikes. Purchasing through the WC Ikes is a membership privilege. It is not intended for a member to purchase items and re-sell them to non-members.
2. To receive the discounted price the member must pre-order items through the Trap Chair or his designee. Items must be picked up and paid in full within one week of being notified that the items have arrived.
3. Ammunition must be ordered in case (10 box) lots. Ammunition inventoried by the WC Ikes will be made available to both members and non-members and be priced at competitive retail pricing. **Inventoried ammunition is not available for purchase at a reduced price.**
4. As a general rule, any shooting supplies inventoried by the WC Ikes shall have a minimum mark-up of the price calculation stated in the General Information paragraph above PLUS a 10% inventory fee.
5. Any member who has an outstanding balance due is not eligible to pre-order shooting supplies at a reduced rate.
6. It is the responsibility of the trap chair or his/her designee in consultation with the President and Treasurer to set pricing.
