TURKEY SHOOT – OCTOBER 29TH

Registration starts at 8am with first shoot at 9am. Fees for the rifle, muzzleloader, and handgun events are \$10 and trap is \$15. \$5 from each entry per event will be jackpotted back with a split of 50%, 30%, and 20% for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place per event. Events are as follows:

- Centerfire rifle- Open class bench rest. 100 yards four five shot strings.
- Rimfire rifle- Open class bench rest. 100 yards four five shot strings.
- Rimfire rifle- Iron sights. 25 yards four five shot strings.
- Modern muzzleloader- Open class bench rest. 100 yards four five shot strings.
- Primitive muzzleloader- Iron sights. 25 yards four five shot strings.
- Centerfire handgun- Iron sights. 25 yards four five shot strings.
- Trap- 25 16 yard targets and 25 handicap targets. Handicap will be the score you shoot at 16 yards.

Open class events allow any combination of optics and rests. The rest of the events will be iron sights standing. We will not be going down range to check targets between strings. Bring a spotting scope if you want to check targets.

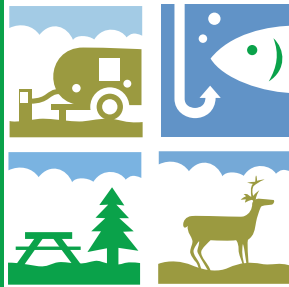
